THE FEDERALISTS, LED BY ALEXANDER HAMILTON FAVORED A STRONG FEDERAL GOVERNMENT. THEY ADMIRER BRITAIN, BECAUSE OF ITS STABILITY AND DISTRICTED

FRANCE IN THE AFTERMATH OF THE FRENCH REVOLUTION. FEDERALISTS FAVORED BANKING AND SHIPPING INTERESTS, AND ENJOYED STRONG SUPPORT IN THE NORTHEAST AND FROM THE WEALTHY PLANTATION OWNERS IN THE SOUTH.

INTERPRETATION OF THE CONSTITUTION. THEY ENJOYED SUPPORT FOR THE PROPOSERS OF REPUBLICAN POLICIES APPEALED TO FARMERS, WORKERS, ESPECIALLY IN THE MIDDLE ATLANTIC
